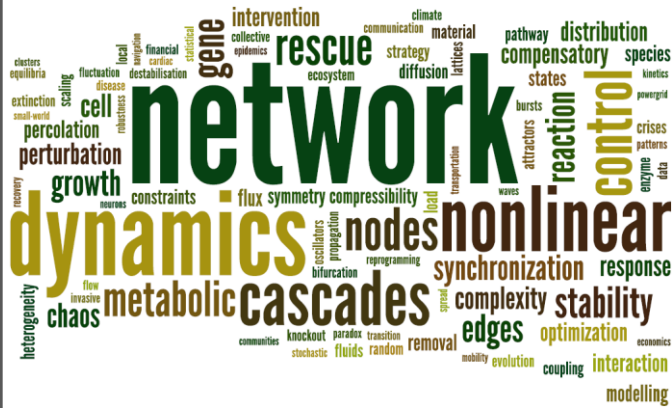


# Network Frontier Workshop
